



The candle-lit Baron's Hall

can be used for:

A civil ceremony with the central fire lit. From mid-October to early November and from mid-February to mid-May, Baron's Hall is only available for ceremonies on weekends after 4pm. From early November to mid-February and on weekdays, ceremonies are available at any time

your drinks reception around the open fire

Garden Room weddings

Located a few steps from the main house, the modern Garden Room offers a bright and spacious interior, with hardwood flooring, and can be used for: your drinks reception, and then later for your evening entertainment, as it's perfect for dancing, with space for your chosen disco or band plus a bar until midnight, for up to 88 guests

The cosy Buttery can also be used for: a more intimate civil ceremony, if required, for up to 40 guests or dining for up to 30 guests

The charming Sunderland Room

can be used for: your civil ceremony for up to 136 guests your drinks reception or your wedding breakfast for up to 88 guests

Marquee weddings

A fully lined, heated & carpeted marquee, erected in the private Inner Courtyard can be used for: your wedding breakfast for up to 160 guests

your evening reception and entertainment, with a fully stocked bar

The cosy Buttery can also be used for: a separate bar area, a few steps away from the marquee

Also included

Access to the formal, Tudor gardens for photo opportunities until dusk (also open to the visiting public until 5pm in October and mid-February to May inclusive)

Use of the sweeping private entrance of Penshurst Place offering a dedicated entrance to Penshurst Place for you and your guests, stunning views of the front of the House, ample, free parking and an area for fireworks, if required

Over the festive period real, decorated Christmas trees are also provided.
